



PRIVACY AND SECURITY

The statement below outlines the meetale.com website ("Meetale") Privacy Policy. Meetale may update its Privacy Policy to reflect changes in the products and services that Meetale offers, however, the underlying goal of protecting user privacy remains the same. By using Meetale's service, each user consents to the collection, use or disclosure of their Personal Information in accordance with this Privacy Policy. Your continued use of the Meetale service following the "last-revised" date on this Privacy Policy will represent your consent to the collection, use or disclosure of your Personal Information under this Privacy Policy as modified. You are advised to review this page regularly for any changes.

STORAGE AND USE OF USER INFORMATION

Meetale stores information as described below that could be used to identify users ("Personal Information") on the Meetale servers for the sole purpose of providing the Meetale service to users. Meetale also stores certain non-personally identifiable information using log files.

The following paragraph describes the Personal Information collected on Meetale servers: email address, name and mailing address, telephone number, city, sex, date of birth, usage records.

COMMUNICATIONS FROM THE SITE UPDATES AND NOTIFICATIONS

The email address of account holder is used for confirmation of a successful account creation. Account holders can opt out from the updates at any time by logging into their account to modify their update preference. Users also have the right to opt in or opt out of communications related to such services as, but not limited to, new application launches, promotions, Meetale contests and events. Meetale may also collect the account holder's cell phone number if the account holder opts in to an SMS alert service.

SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENTS

On rare occasions it is necessary to send out a strictly service related announcement. For instance, if the service is temporarily suspended for maintenance, Meetale might send users an email or SMS message. Generally, users may not opt-out of these communications, though they can deactivate their account. However, these communications are not promotional in nature.

CUSTOMER SERVICE

Meetale communicates with users on a regular basis to provide requested services. In regards to issues relating to their account, Meetale replies via email or phone, in accordance with the user's wishes.

SURVEYS

Occasionally, Meetale's site requests information from users via surveys. Participation in these surveys is completely voluntary and the user therefore has a choice whether or not to disclose information. The requested information typically includes marketing or product feedback information and, in some cases, optional contact and / or demographic information. If provided, contact information may be used for testimonials or to request additional feedback information. Users will be advised and given an opportunity to consent or opt-out of such uses. Anonymous survey information will be used for purposes of monitoring or improving the use and satisfaction of the Meetale website and Meetale service. Users' Personal Information is not shared with third parties unless Meetale provides prior notice and the choice to users. Though Meetale may use an intermediary to conduct these surveys or contests, the intermediary may not use users' Personal Information for any secondary purposes.

ELIGIBILITY

Meetale does not intentionally collect or use personal information about individuals under the age of 13. Consequently, use of this web and mobile internet site and all related services by children under the age of 13 is strictly prohibited. Meetale reserves the right to delete, move, edit, refuse to post or take other appropriate action with respect to any messages, information or files which Meetale, in its sole discretion, deems objectionable or otherwise in violation of the terms and conditions of this Agreement.

COOKIES

A cookie is a piece of data stored on the users' computer or cellular phone tied to information about the user. Meetale uses session ID cookies. However, the user must opt-in to the usage of cookies by indicating that their login credentials be remembered when they login in subsequent sessions. Meetale may also use cookies that are not linked to any Personal Information to store certain preferences about the user's use of the services. For example, cookies may be used to allow a user to set a preference to skip a verification screen when capturing information.

AGGREGATE INFORMATION

Meetale may use users' Personal Information to generate aggregated information that does not allow the user to be personally identified or contacted. Aggregated Information shows user activity as a whole rather than on an individual basis and may be used by Meetale to provide insight on the usage of the Meetale services.

Meetale allows third-party companies to serve ads and/or collect certain anonymous information when you visit our web site. These companies may use non-personally identifiable information (e.g., click stream information, browser type, time and date, subject of advertisements clicked or scrolled over) during your visits to this and other Web sites in order to provide advertisements about goods and services likely to be of greater interest to you. These companies typically use a cookie or third party web beacon to collect this information.

WEB AND MOBILE INTERNET SITE ACTIVITY

Like most standard Web and mobile internet sites, Meetale stores and uses web server log files. These files include anonymous information about web browsers, such as internet protocol (IP) addresses, browser type, internet service provider (ISP), referring/exit pages, platform type, date/time stamp, and number of clicks to analyze trends, administer the site, track users' movement in the aggregate, and gather broad demographic information for aggregate use. Such log files are not linked to Personal Information through the Meetale service.

SHARING

Meetale will not share any information provided by users, except as follows:

Aggregate Information (non-personally identifiable)

Meetale may use users' Personal Information to generate aggregated information relating to activity on Meetale-enabled products and services. This aggregate information does not allow the user to be personally identified or contacted and shows user activity as a whole rather than on an individual basis. This information is shared with relevant Meetale customers and partners.

When Meetale Discloses User Information

Meetale may share users Personal Information with its affiliates, subsidiaries and service providers for the sole purpose of providing the Meetale service to the user, provided that the information is required for and used only for such purpose and provided the information is used in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

Meetale will otherwise only release Personal Information to third parties in the following limited circumstances:

- (i) if a law, regulation, search warrant, subpoena or court order legally requires Meetale to do so;
- (ii) if Meetale's rights or property or the rights or property of Meetale's affiliates, subsidiaries, service providers or the users of Meetale's web site or services are in jeopardy;
- (iii) if the personal safety of users of Meetale's web site or services or other members of the public is in jeopardy.
- (iv) if user signup thought Meetale registration page of partner (for example in case of contest/event area)

Business Transitions

In the event Meetale goes through a business transition, such as a merger, being acquired by another company, or selling a portion of its assets, users' Personal Information will, in most instances, be one of the assets transferred. Users will be notified via email prior to a change of ownership or control of their Personal Information. If, as a result of the business transition, the users' Personal Information will be used in a manner different from that stated at the time of collection, users will be given a choice to decline such different use.

SECURITY

Meetale employs security measures in order to prevent the loss, misuse, unauthorized access, theft and alteration of Personal Information under Meetale's control. However, no transmission over the Internet can be guaranteed to be completely secure. Consequently, Meetale, its affiliates, subsidiaries, service providers and their respective officers, directors, employees and agents do not represent, warrant or guarantee that Personal Information will be protected against misuse, loss or alterations and do not accept any liability for Personal Information submitted to or collected by them nor for your or third parties' use or misuse of Personal Information.

CORRECTING/UPDATING/DELETING/DEACTIVATING PERSONAL INFORMATION

If a user's Personal Information changes (such as phone, email address or cellular phone number), the user may update this information on the Meetale website or on their cellular phone. If a user no longer desires to use Meetale's service, Meetale provides a way to delete/deactivate users' Personal Information. Account deletion/deactivation can be done online www.Meetale.com
